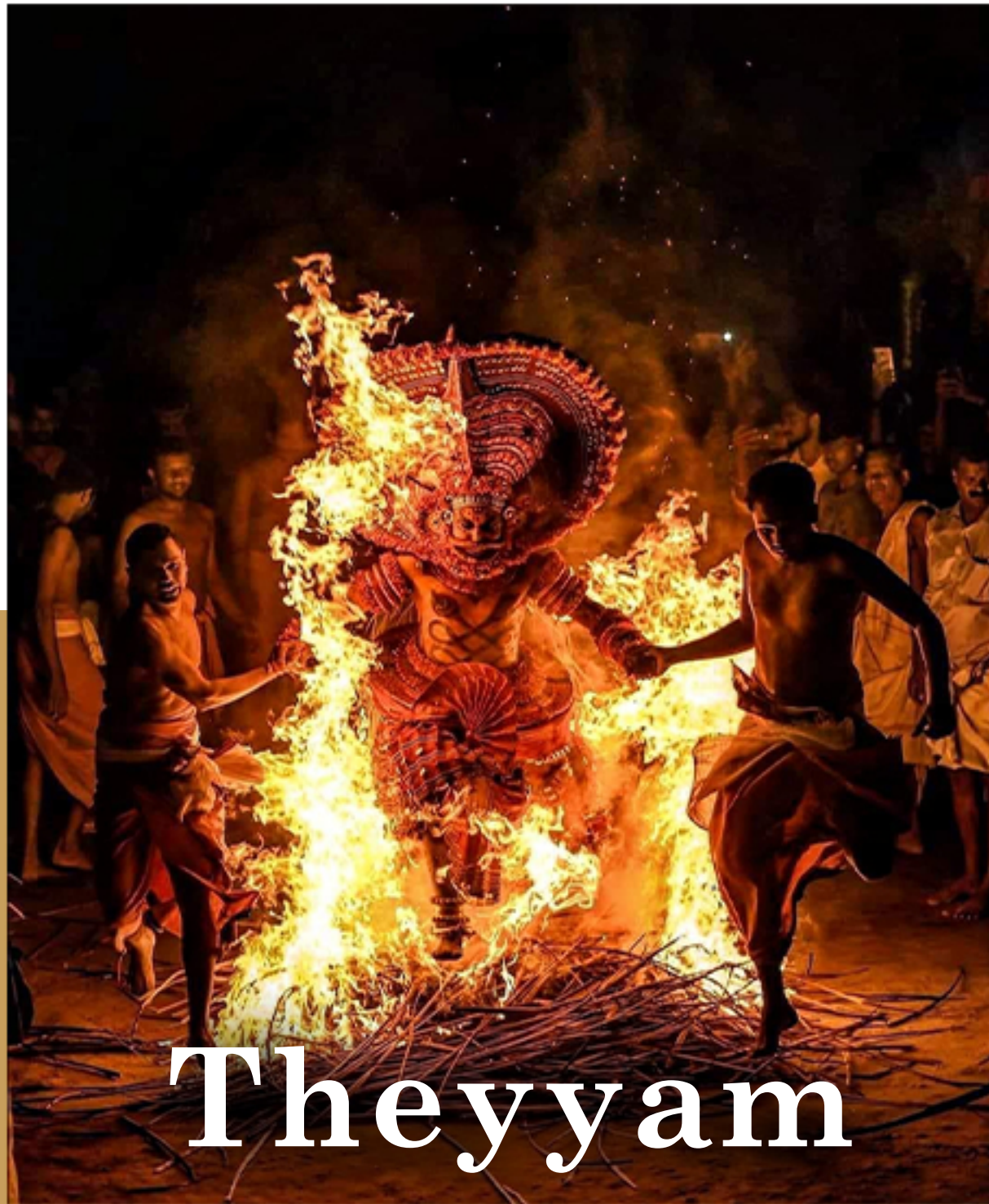
Mohiniyattam
